NOTICE OF DECISION

AMENDMENT TO EXISTING WATERWORKS SYSTEM

In accordance with section 70 of the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act, the Town of St. Paul has been issued an approval by Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development for an amendment to an existing approval to have a third DAF train, additional raw water pump, ozone generator, media replacement for filters, using CO₂ instead of H₂SO₄ and other repair as per the application submitted on February 23, 2015. This waterworks gets raw water from the North Saskatchewan River via Lac St. Cyr and supplies water to Town of St. Paul and Town of Elk Point. The operation is located in the NW ¼ of Section 24 Township 57 Range 09 West of the 4th Meridian.

The *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* may provide you a right of appeal against this decision to the Alberta Environmental Appeals Board. You should note that there are strict time lines for filing an appeal dependent on the type of appeal. If you choose to appeal this decision, please contact:
