section 606 of the Municipal Government Act (MGA).

These written submissions will be included in the Council agenda package and should be clearly marked to include the Bylaw number. Oral submissions may be made at the Public Hearing without prior notification to the Town of St. Paul.

Please note that the Public Hearing for Bylaw No. 1249 will start at 7:30 p.m. followed by the Public Hearing for Bylaw No. 1250. The public hearings will occur sequentially, but those who wish to participate should be in attendance at 7:30 p.m. as each public hearing will commence as soon after 7:30 p.m. as any prior hearing is concluded. Submissions will become part of the public record, and, as such, will be subject to the provisions of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

Interested in building a fence?

A development permit is required if you are planning on installing a fence on your property. The regulations for Fences, Walls, and Hedges can be found under 7.13 (Pages 73 and 74) of the Town of St. Paul's Land Use Bylaw. A fence can be installed on your property line if you sign a declaration that you have located the survey pins. Summer time can be a busy time of year for Planning & Development, therefore, we ask you to please plan ahead. The processing times for the issuance of a development permit can be up to 40 days if all regulations (setbacks/heights) are met in the Land Use Bylaw.

**A fence must be installed within your own property boundaries. These regulations do not authorize the development of fences on public property or utility rights-of-way, unless permission is granted by Council and an encroachment agreement is approved and registered on title at the cost of the landowner.*

Grass Clippings & Yard Waste Guidelines

Stickers are being sold of the Town of St. Paul Administration Office.

Stickers are \$5.00 (tax incl.)

Maximum of 5 Bags per pickup

Must be bagged in a transparent (blue or clear) bag only.

Sticker must be noticeable on 1 of the 5 bags and clearly separated from household garbage.

Bags must be no larger than 30" x 35" (76.2cmx 83.8cmx 26.7cm) fits up to 30 gallon (113.6 L) can.

This program is for:

- Seniors who are unable to deliver their clippings to the Transfer Station themselves.
- Residents with a medical condition unable to deliver their clippings to the Transfer Station.
