A Message from the Regional Deputy Director of Emergency Management

The Region of St. Paul is encouraging residents to sign up for MyAlberta Digital ID. Signing up will allow people to access participating government services. This includes access to health records, registries, park passes, post-secondary student aid and the ability to apply to attend post-secondary institutions. MyAlberta Digital ID also allows access apprenticeship training program information, employment standards and occupational health and safety.

More and more services are added to the system all the time. Recently the MyAlberta Emergency Registration System (MAERS) has been launched and it works in conjunction with the MyAlberta Digital ID system. MAERS allows Albertans who are evacuated from an area to register remotely or virtually without having to travel to a reception centre as has been the case in the past.
