MUNICIPAL ENFORCEMENT



St. Paul Municipal Enforcement has been receiving complaints/concerns regarding motorist action at marked crosswalks regarding near misses. Most recently St. Paul Municipal Enforcement released a reminder for all motorists to be sure and allow pedestrians the right of way within marked crosswalks focusing predominantly on the school zones, however ALL crosswalks are required to be treated in the same manner.

The **intersection of 50th Avenue and 48th Street** has been identified as an intersection where recent reports of near miss vehicle vs pedestrian incidents have occurred. When making any turn onto or off of 50th Avenue and there is pedestrian activity, drivers are required to wait until the pedestrian has made it safely to the opposite side before putting their vehicle in motion. It is also important to that pedestrian are required by the same legislation to cross the roadway as quickly as possible bearing in mind physical abilities.

It is a collective responsibility to ensure that both drivers and pedestrians take the appropriate caution and responsibility to ensure safety on the roadways with the town of St. Paul.
