MUNICIPAL ENFORCEMENT

School Safety

As the start of the 2021/2022 school approaches, St. Paul Municipal Enforcement wishes to remind residents of the community that the school zones will once again be actively patrolled to ensure the safety of the kids as they go to and from school. In the interest of pedestrian safety

St. Paul Municipal Enforcement wishes to ensure residents make themselves aware of the specific school zone time periods and adhere to the designated speed limits while operating a motor vehicle within all school and playground zones.

Common contraventions observed by Municipal Enforcement include but are not limited to the following:

- Speeding, or exceed maximum speed limit in a school zone, 30 kph
- Fail to obey stop sign before entering an intersection, or fail to obey traffic control
- Failing to yield for pedestrian in a crosswalk, (Note: this means that drivers are required to stop in advance of the crosswalk and remain

stopped until the pedestrian is safely on the opposite sidewalk - curb to curb)

• Distracted driving, or operate a vehicle while holding/viewing/ manipulating a handheld / wireless device.

These sections of the Traffic Safety Act/Rules of the Road are in place to mitigate risk of serious injury should be adhered to at all times. Pedestrians also have a responsibility to ensure they follow the proper rules when entering the traveled portion of the roadway, which includes ensuring vehicles have stopped in both directions and crossing is done in an expedient manner. Simply pushing the crosswalk button and entering the traveled portion of the roadway is an unsafe practice. The pedestrian may have the right of way, but injury will occur if precautions are not taken.
