Happy August everyone! Despite the dry conditions and wildfire smoke I sincerely hope everyone has been able to spend some quality time outdoors this summer. Heat has certainly been the common theme this season with little rain fall which raises a concern around water usage in town. Although we have not imposed a water restriction to the public we are simply asking that you keep it in mind. A couple things to consider when watering your lawn can be watering less often, cut down on the time spent watering and also watering at night and early mornings. Some industries out there may be in favor of the dry conditions from a business interruption standpoint but we can't help but feel for the farmers right now who are dealing with a number of issues stemming from the drought conditions in our area.

Our pilot program for the garbage pickup with the residential waste carts seems to be moving along fairly smooth now that we are five months into the process. A gentle reminder to everyone that this program kicked off in May of 2021 with back alley pick up (or where your previous pick up location was) and will continue through the winter months into the Spring of 2022. We have been and will continue to collect information from ratepayers and staff on how the current route system has functioned in order to make informed decisions on any changes that may need to happen going forward.

Very happy to report to citizens that our 57th street road construction project has begun and will continue through the month of August and into September. I look forward to everyone having an upgraded road with a paved surface to travel on.

Another positive note for me to pass along is that our Council is headed back to our chambers for in person meetings for the first time in what seemed to be a very long, long time. Delegations will once again be allowed back into the room to participate in our meetings but will also have the opportunity to join us on line as we will continue to live stream too.
