The successful candidate will be highly motivated, organized and responsible for maintaining our fleet of turf moving equipment, tractors, trucks, carts and various other smaller pieces and tools. Included in this position is effectively making timely and efficient repairs to keep equipment in rotation and performing at high level as well as other directives as assigned by the Golf Course Superintendent.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Repair and maintain all pieces of golf course equipment including utility vehicles, reel and rotary mowers, tractors, turf moving equipment, etc.
- 2. Service and maintain equipment on a regular basis
- 3. Record keeping including servicing requirements, parts inventory, purchases and repairs performed for each piece equipment
- 4. Ability to support on-course maintenance staff with equipment related issues
- 5. Keep precision cutting units sharp and correctly adjusted
- 6. Responsible for managing a fleet of Golf Carts
