^{*}To be eligible for the altered animal rate, pet owners must include <u>documented proof of spay or neuter</u>, such as an official letter from your veterinarian or a receipt from the procedure, when submitting the completed animal licensing form.

Reasons to License Your Pet

- Provides identification of animal to Community Peace Officer so it may be returned to you.

Why Should I get a License Every Year?

- People move.
- People change phone numbers.
- Animals are given away to other owners in town (dog license needs to be renewed when a new owner acquires the pet).
- The Town of St. Paul will have the most up-to-date owner and animal information.

It is the pet owner's responsibility to ensure that information provided is current, and up-to-date.
