SECTION 1.0 – POLICY STATEMENT AND GUIDELINES

1. The Town of St. Paul desires to offer a take-it-or-leave-it area at its Waste Transfer Facility to provide the public with an opportunity to reuse items that are eligible while ensuring the safety of the public.

SECTION 2.0 – PROHIBITED ITEMS

- 1. No prohibited items shall be deposited in the Take-It-Or-Leave-It Areas as listed in Section 3.3 of the Evergreen Waste Management Services Commission Operations Plan for the Town of St. Paul's Waste Transfer Facility.
- 2. No carpets, linoleum, clothing, shoes, bedding, food items, mattresses, box springs, baby walkers, cribs, carseats, refrigerators, freezers, stoves, dishwashers, microwaves, washing machines, clothes dryers, hot water tanks, humidifiers, de-humidifiers, televisions, any similar appliances, or any type of Personal Protective Equipment including but not limited to helmets, hard hats, safety boots, masks, or life jackets.
- 3. Any material placed in the Municipal Solid Waste bins, inert waste cells, metal site, appliance site, tire-marshalling area, or burn pits may not be transferred to the Take-It-Or-Leave-It Area.
- 4. Items must be clean, in reasonably good condition, and may require minor repairs.

SECTION 3.0 – DISCRETION

- 1. The Site Attendant shall have final discretion regarding which items are acceptable and they may refuse any item for any reason.
- 2. Items that have been left in the Take-It-Or-Leave-It Area for more than thirty (30) days are to be disposed of by any means of recycling or salvaging as a last resort of waste disposal.
